STREET ADDRESSES



RULE 7: Capitalize street addresses. That includes the name of the street, the direction, and abbreviations such as St., Rd., Blvd., Ave., and Dr. Do NOT capitalize the direction and words such as street, road, and avenue when they are not part of the street name.

Example: Dr. Alvarez has moved from W. State Street to Bay Blvd. His new street is north of my home.
