## HOW CATALOGS ARE ARRANGED

A **catalog** is a book that lists those items that a store or company has to sell. Very often what a company or business sells are called **items**. Some catalogs simply have pictures and descriptions of all the items that they sell. On one page there might be pictures of stationery, satin covered-hangers, and vases. Larger catalogs arrange the items by categories. For example, all the women's clothing is in one section.
